Mark Krawczyk said there has been a number of issues with documentation to support the position as first lien holder when we issued the bonds and we are going to have to reset the clock and start all over.



Councillor Sorg Moved to Adjourn and Mayor Pro-Tem Smith Seconded the motion.


Mayor Miyagishima said all of those in favor signify by saying "Aye."
