



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAS CRUCES MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 2-1011, JOINT BOARDS, SCOPE, TO REDUCE THE TERM OF APPOINTMENT OF CITY MEMBERS TO THE EXTRATERRITORIAL ZONING AUTHORITY.**

**PURPOSE(S) OF ACTION:** To amend the Las Cruces Municipal Code ("LCMC"), Section 2-1011, to reduce the term of appointment of City members to the Extraterritorial Zoning Authority ("ETZA") to two (2) years, limited to no more than two (2) consecutive appointments.

**BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:** The Las Cruces ETZA is a City/County organization which coordinates growth management, zoning and subdivision administration within the five-mile extraterritorial zone surrounding the City of Las Cruces.

Members of the ETZA are comprised of elected City and County officials. The members of the ETZA are City elected official members appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council.

It is in the best interests of the City to reduce the term for City members to the ETZA from the current term of no more than eight (8) consecutive years (LCMC, Section 2-188(b)(11)), to a term of two (2) years, limited to no more than two (2) consecutive appointments.

**THAT** LCMC, Section 2-1011, *Joint Boards, Scope* is hereby enacted to read as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

**(II)**

**THAT** City staff is authorized to do all deeds necessary to accomplish the intent of this Ordinance.



**DIVISION 4.**

**JOINT BOARDS**

**Subdivision I.**

**In General**

**Sec. 2-1011. Scope.**

(a) Joint board members appointed by the city shall comply with division 1 of this article, unless stated otherwise, in the board's joint powers agreement, joint or concurring resolution, certificate of association, or rules and regulations and such agreements, resolutions, certificates of association, or rules and regulations that are not inconsistent with state law.

(b) The city council may waive subsection 2-188(b)(11) for city-appointed joint board members if the city council determines such a waiver is in the city's best interest.

(c) The term of appointment to the Extraterritorial Zoning Authority shall be for two years and limited to no more than two consecutive appointments.

(d) The joint boards include the following:

- (1) Economic Development Council;
- (2) Extraterritorial Zoning Commission;
- (3) Extraterritorial Zoning Authority;
- (4) Keep America Beautiful --Community Pride;
- (5) Memorial Medical Center Board of Directors;
- (6) Metropolitan Planning Organization;
- (7) Rio Grande Natural Gas Association Board;
- (8) South Central Solid Waste Authority; and
- (9) University Avenue Corridor Citizen's Design Review Committee.

(e) This section applies only to city members.
