BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

The City of Las Cruces was awarded \$228,000.00 from the State of New Mexico as a result of legislative appropriation through the New Mexico Department of Transportation, Municipal Arterial Program to fund NMDOT Project No. MAP-7613 (903), Control No. HW2 L100002: the Rehabilitation of Amador Avenue from Archuleta Street to Motel Boulevard Project, in the amount of \$228,000.00 under resolution 10-049 on August 3, 2009.

During their January 20, 2010 meeting, the State Transportation Commission heard and approved award reductions for the 2009/2010 Local Government Road Fund Program (see NMDOT letter dated January 21, 2010). As a result of the approval, grant funding for the above mentioned project has been reduced to reflect the following: NMDOT grant award of \$179,126.00.

This resolution shall amend the original Municipal Arterial Program Agreement to revise the project funding amounts from \$228,000.00 to \$179,126.00 for the NMDOT Project No. MAP-7613 (903), Control No. HW2 L100002: the Rehabilitation of Amador Avenue from Archuleta Street to Motel Boulevard Project. The City match requirement also decreased from \$76,000.00 to \$59,708.67. However, staff recommends the budget for the match remain the same, which will be above the required amount in order to have sufficient funding toward the total project cost of \$408,643.95.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM, FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$228,000.00 FOR THE REHABILITATION OF AMADOR AVENUE FROM ARCHULETA STREET TO MOTEL BOULEVARD PROJECT AND TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010 BUDGET.

The City Council of the City of Las Cruces is informed that:

WHEREAS, the City of Las Cruces and the New Mexico Department of Transportation have entered into a joint and coordinated effort in Municipal Arterial Program Cooperative Agreement Project Number MAP-7613(903), Control Number L100002 known as Municipal Arterial Project for Fiscal Year 2009/2010 for the rehabilitation of Amador Avenue from Archuleta Street to Motel Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Cruces is being offered an award of \$228,000.00 from the New Mexico Department of Transportation, Municipal Arterial Program for this project; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$228,000.00, and the City of Las Cruces is required to match 25% of the total project award amount of \$304,000.00, for a match of \$76,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Cruces is required to fund the difference between the total project award amount of \$304,000.00 and the actual cost of the project which will incorporate the additional funding necessary for design, construction costs, materials testing, and inspection for the project; and

WHEREAS, the agreement terminates on June 30, 2011 and the City of

Las Cruces incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation requires the City to pass a resolution that references the scope of work and monetary amounts submitted to the State Highway Commission and that the project is adopted and has priority standing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Cruces has the remaining necessary funding in place and has commenced with the project design plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces:

(I)

THAT the City of Las Cruces will enter into a Municipal Arterial Program Cooperative Agreement for Project Number MAP-7613(903), Control Number L100002 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation, Municipal Arterial Project, Fiscal Year 2009/2010 for the Rehabilitation of Amador Avenue from Archuleta Street to Motel Boulevard Project.

THAT the grant from the New Mexico Department of Transportation, Municipal Arterial Program, in the amount of \$228,000.00 is hereby accepted and the City of Las Cruces will commit \$76,000.00 in matching funds and all additional construction costs.

(III)

THAT the Fiscal Year 2009/2010 Budget is hereby amended as outlined on the attached Exhibit "A".

THAT City staff is hereby authorized to do all deeds necessary in the accomplishment of the herein above.






