BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS: Beginning in January 2005, the Las Cruces City Council started a pilot project to dedicate one Monday a month to only Land Use Management. The fourth Monday of each month was scheduled to hear ordinances and resolutions which pertained to land use. The pilot program was to be for six months, and evaluation made on the success of having this extra meeting.

After six months of conducting Land Use Management meetings on the fourth Monday of each month, the Las Cruces City Council determined it an effective method to address land use issues only during one meeting. An ordinance was adopted on August 1, 2005, approving the addition of the third meeting.

At the Council meeting of July 26, 2010, Council gave consensus to bring forth a resolution to cancel the remainder of the year's third meeting of the month and agreed to only hold a Regular Meeting twice a month.

The City Council is informed that:

WHEREAS, the rules of order on meeting schedules allows for regular meetings on the first, third and fourth Mondays of each month; and

WHEREAS, City Council gave consensus at the Regular City Council meeting of July 26, 2010 to bring forth a resolution to amend the remainder of the Regular Meeting Schedule for Calendar Year 2010, cancelling the September, October and November third meeting of the month; and

WHEREAS, City Council gave consensus to change the meeting schedules to only have two Regular City Council Meetings a month to be held at 1:00 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces:

(I)

THAT, Section 2-27(c)(2)a, entitled "Meeting schedules:", is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) *Meeting schedules.*

a. The council shall conduct regular meetings on the first and third Mondays of each month in the City Council Chambers of City Hall at 1:00 p.m. If the day for a regular meeting falls on a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held on the next succeeding day not a holiday or as otherwise directed by council. By a vote of four or more councillors, the date, time, and/or location of a regular meeting may be changed in order to allow the councillors to attend a special function or event.

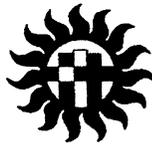

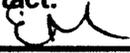
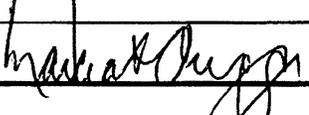

§ 2.09

office or employment until one (1) year after the expiration of the term for which the councillor or mayor was elected.

(b) *Appointments and removals.* Neither the council nor its individual members shall in any manner dictate the appointment or removal of any city administrative officer or employee whom the city manager or any of the manager's subordinates are empowered to appoint.

(c) *Interference with administration.* Neither the mayor, council nor individual councillors shall in any manner usurp the administrative authority of the city manager set forth in Article III. (Ord. No. 1077, 7-3-89)

Sec. 2.06. Vacancies; forfeiture of office; filling of vacancies.

(a) *Vacancies.* The office of councillor shall become vacant upon the councillor's death, resignation, recall, moving of residence from the district from which elected, or forfeiture of office. The office of mayor shall become vacant upon the mayor's death, resignation, recall, moving of residence to outside the city limits, or forfeiture of office.

(b) *Forfeiture of office.* A councillor or mayor may be removed from office in accordance with the general laws of the State of New Mexico.

(c) *Filling of vacancies.* A vacancy in the council, occurring more than nine (9) months prior to the next regular election, shall be filled by a special election to be held within sixty (60) days of the vacancy. The councillor or mayor so elected shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term for which the councillor or mayor who vacated the position was elected. A vacancy occurring less than nine (9) months prior to the next regular election shall be filled by the appointment by the council of a person who is a qualified voter residing in the district in which the vacancy exists, or in the case of the mayor, be [by] a qualified voter residing in the city. The appointed councillor or mayor shall serve until the next regular election, at which time a councillor or mayor shall be elected to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term for which the councillor or mayor who vacated the position was elected.

Notwithstanding the requirement hereinafter in this Charter that a quorum of the council consists of four (4) members, if at any time the membership of the council is reduced to fewer than four (4) members, the remaining members may, by majority action, enforce the provisions of this section.

(Ord. No. 1077, 7-3-89; Ord. No. 2222, § I, 8-1-05)

Sec. 2.07. Certification of elections.

The council shall certify the results of all city elections.

Sec. 2.08. Procedure.

(a) *Meetings.* The council shall meet regularly at least twice in every month at such times and places as the council may prescribe by ordinance. Special meetings may be held on the call of the mayor or of four (4) or more members and, whenever practicable, upon no less than twelve (12) hours' notice to each member. All meetings shall be subject to state statutes regarding open meetings. Closed or executive sessions may be conducted only as authorized by the statutes of the State of New Mexico.

(b) *Rules and records.* The council shall determine its own rules, policies and order of business and shall provide for keeping records of its proceedings. These records shall be public.

(c) *Voting.* Voting, except on procedural motions, shall be by roll call, and each councillor's vote shall be recorded in the records. Four (4) members of the council shall constitute a quorum. No action of the council, except as otherwise provided in Section 2.06, shall be valid or binding unless adopted by the affirmative vote of four (4) or more members of the council.

Sec. 2.09. Action requiring an ordinance.

In addition to other acts required by law or by specific provisions of this Charter to be adopted by ordinance, the following acts of the city council shall also be adopted by ordinance:

(a) Provision for a fine or other penalty no higher than that imposed by statute for a petty misdemeanor;

odic work sessions. Instructions may be given to the city manager at work sessions, but no official action may be taken.

(2) *Meeting schedules.*

- a. The council shall conduct regular meetings on the first, third and fourth Mondays of each month. The fourth Monday of each month will be dedicated to land use management. If the day for a regular meeting falls on a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held on the next succeeding day not a holiday or as otherwise directed by the council. By a vote of four or more councillors, the date, time, and/or location of a regular meeting may be changed in order to allow the councillors to attend a special function or event.
- b. Special meetings may be held upon the call of the mayor or of four or more councillors and, whenever practical, upon no less than 24 hours' notice to each councillor and the public.
- c. The council may meet in work sessions as directed by the council.
- d. Regular and special meetings or work sessions may be canceled with the consent of four or more councillors.

(3) *Agenda.*

- a. The agenda for regular meetings shall be set by the mayor or, in the absence of the mayor, by the mayor pro tem, in open meetings with the city manager and senior staff on the Monday immediately preceding regular council meetings, official holidays excepted. Councillors other than the mayor or the mayor pro tem shall not discuss the proposed agenda during the agenda meeting.
- b. The agenda for work sessions shall be determined by council consent. The city manager shall maintain a list of work session topics for the

guidance of the council. Copies of the agenda shall be made available to the public as early in advance of the work sessions as is feasible, but in no instance shall the public be given less than 24 hours' notice of such meetings.

- c. All meetings shall be subject to state statutes regarding open meetings.
- (d) *Voting; quorum.* The procedures for voting and a quorum shall be as follows:
 - (1) Voting, except for procedural matters, shall be taken by roll call, and each councillor's vote shall be recorded in the minutes.
 - (2) The city clerk shall call the vote of the council as follows:
 - a. The clerk shall call the vote in council district order, except that the mayor pro tem shall be the last councillor to vote.
 - b. The clerk shall call the mayor's vote last.
 - c. If one or more of the councillors is absent, the clerk shall call the vote of the next councillor in district order, except that the mayor pro tem shall be the last councillor to vote.
 - (3) Four members shall constitute a quorum at any location. Any action by the council shall not be valid unless adopted by the affirmative vote of four or more members.
 - (4) If vacancies reduce the council to fewer than four members, the remaining councillors may, by majority vote, take action consistent with the Charter to fill the vacancies.

(e) *General procedure of council.* General procedures of the council shall be as follows:

- (1) *Recognition.* The mayor or, in his absence, the mayor pro tem shall chair the meetings of the council. If neither the mayor nor mayor pro tem is present, the council shall, by majority vote, select one of its members to chair the meeting. Councillors wishing to speak to matters before the council, to the city manager or mem-
