Library Services to County Residents

- Community Centers managed by DAC Health and Human Services
 - Chaparral
 - Organ
 - Rincon
 - Del Cerro
 - Radium Springs
 - Butterfield *

*managed by DAC Facilities

Community Center cont.

- Each center has 300-500 books
- Paid DAC staff person on site
 - Monday – Friday; 8AM – 5PM
 - Butterfield has volunteer Monday-Friday
- 0-2 public computers available
 - For word processing only
- No broadband service available

Limited library services

- Books-by-Mail Service for those who have broadband service
- No ability to review online library catalog
 - Use of phone to request books to be mailed or delivered to site
- No public computer classes

- provide additional items to the current collections
- rotate material on a quarterly basis.
