The City has procured the services of Walker Parking Consultants of Denver, CO to update the downtown parking study from 2008. The consultants will be in town on April 11th and 12th for inventory and parking lot counts within the entire downtown area.

Staff has coordinated with both the consultants and the Downtown Revitalization Ad Hoc Committee to have a committee meeting. This meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 11th from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm in Rooms 2007 B & C, City Hall, 700 N. Main Street. This meeting will give an overview of the data collection and modeling process by the consultants and give opportunity for the committee to provide ideas and suggestions related to the project scope and further needs.

Additionally, on April 12th at 5:30 pm in the City Council Chambers, an input meeting will be hosted by City staff with the consultants to gather general public input about parking issues for downtown.

Based on the two meetings listed above, a refined/expanded scope will be put forth and next steps identified for both staff and the consultant.
