

**BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:**

On October 2, 2012, the City of Las Cruces was notified by the Southwest Border High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) Program – New Mexico that the Executive Office of the President, Office of National Drug Control Policy has increased Federal grant award number G11SN0006A by \$18,000.00, bringing the total grant award amount to \$828,190.83. The City of Las Cruces acts as fiscal agent on behalf of HIDTA for the grant award. Grant funds are expressly used to support the Regional Interagency Drug Task Force and the Warren Reese Southern New Mexico High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Law Enforcement Center for various initiatives as prescribed under the program.

Grant funding is budgeted in Fund 7422: Metro HIDTA under project number 13012. Budgeted grants funds will be increased by \$18,000.00. Funds are drawn-down as needed by Metro HIDTA for expenses related to overtime, general supplies, lease payments, travel, various services, and classified expenditures. Expenditures to date total \$799,155.83 leaving the balance of available budgeted funds at \$11,045.00. This action will increase the available budgeted grant funds to \$29,045.00 for this fiscal year.
