

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAS CRUCES MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTIONS 2-27(C)(2)B AND 2-27(C)(3)B CONCERNING *RULES OF ORDER, PROCEDURE, AND THEREFORE COMPLYING WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT.*

To increase time that public bodies must make the final agenda available.

BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

House Bill 21 amends the Open Meetings Act (OMA) to increase the time that public bodies must make the final agenda available from at least 24 hours prior to a meeting to at least 72 hours, except in the case of an emergency (as defined in the existing Act as matters arising from unforeseen circumstances that if not addressed immediately will likely result in injury, damages to persons or property, or substantial financial loss to the public body). For public bodies that ordinarily meet more frequently than once a week, a draft agenda must be posted at least 72 hours prior to the meeting and final agenda be posted 36 hours prior to the meeting. This bill also requires that agendas be posted on the public body's website within the specified time periods if a website is maintained; all emergency measures adopted must be submitted to the attorney general within 10 days of the meeting at which the action was taken, provided that the requirement to report to the Attorney General is waived due to a state or national emergency.

House Bill 21 will become effective June 14, 2013. All city board staff liaisons have been notified of the change and have been provided with a copy of the amendment.

**COUNCIL BILL NO. 13-030
ORDINANCE NO. 2685**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAS CRUCES MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTIONS 2-27(C)(2)B AND 2-27(C)(3)B CONCERNING *RULES OF ORDER, PROCEDURE, AND THEREFORE COMPLYING WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT.*

The City Council is informed that:

WHEREAS, House Bill 21 amends the Open Meetings Act (OMA) to increase the time that a public body must make the final agenda available from at least 24 hours prior to a meetings to at least 72 hours, except in the case of an emergency (as defined in the existing Act as matters arising from unforeseen circumstances that if not addressed immediately will likely result in injury, damage to persons or property, or substantial financial loss to the public body. For public bodies that ordinarily meet more frequently than once a week, a draft agenda must be posted at least 72 hours prior to the meeting and final agenda be posted 36 hours prior to the meeting;

WHEREAS, the bill also requires the agenda be posted on the public body's website within the specified time periods if a website is maintained;

WHEREAS, all emergency measures adopted must be submitted to the attorney general within 10 days of the meeting at which the action was taken, provided that the requirement to report to the Attorney General is waived due to a state or national emergency;

WHEREAS, House Bill 21 goes into effect on June 14, 2103; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces:

(I)

THAT LCMC 1997, Section 2-27(c)(2)b is amended to read as follows:

Special meetings may be held upon the call of the mayor or of four or more councillors and, whenever practical, upon no less than 72 hours' notice to each councillor and the public.

(II)

THAT LCMC 1997, Section 2-27(c)(3)b is amended to read as follows:

The agenda for work sessions shall be determined by council consent. The city manager shall maintain a list of work session topics for the guidance of the council. Copies of the agenda shall be made available to the public as early in advance of the work sessions as feasible, but in no instance shall the public be given less than 72 hours' notice of such meetings.

(III)

THAT City staff is hereby authorized to do all deeds necessary in the accomplishment of the herein above.
