

BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

On October 6, 2014, the City of Las Cruces was notified by the Southwest Border High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas Program – New Mexico (HIDTA) that the Executive Office of the President, Office of National Drug Control Policy of an increase of federal grant funds (number G14SN0006A) in the amount of \$27,318.00, bringing the total grant award amount to \$865,304.00. This increase of funding allotment will be used by HIDTA Program staff for travel and various services expenses as approved by HIDTA.

The City of Las Cruces acts as fiscal agent on behalf of HIDTA for the grant award. Grant funds are expressly used to support the Regional Interagency Drug Task Force and the Warren Reese Southern New Mexico High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Law Enforcement Center for various initiatives as prescribed under the program.

BUDGET NARRATIVE

This grant instrument provides funding for two entities, Metro Narcotics and the newly formed CLC HIDTA. Grant funding for each entity must be accounted for separately to meet fiscal audit standards. This increase in grant funding is specific to CLC HIDTA to cover general supplies, purchased services and travel expenses for the former "Mesilla HIDTA" staff and will be budgeted in Fund 7492: CLC HIDTA under project number 13015. Funds are drawn-down as needed by HIDTA staff for expenses related to general supplies, travel, and various services. The balance of grant funding has already been established in a separate Fund for use by Metro Narcotics staff.
