BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

In late February 2006 the Dona Ana Office of Emergency Management (OEM) was informed that the State of New Mexico would make the final purchases of equipment requested from the 2005 Department of Homeland Security state grant allocations.

The Las Cruces Police Department made sub-grantee requests for this equipment in 2005. The department will receive 30 LT Level IIIA Ballistic Helmets, valued at \$9,810 and approximately 20 sets of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) valued at \$29,017.14.

The City Council is informed that:

WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico Department of Public Safety, Office of Emergency Management has allocated \$38,827.14 out of the 2005 Department of Homeland Security State grant funds for equipment purchases for the Las Cruces Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the Las Cruces Police Department made requests as a sub-grantee to the State for the equipment in late 2005, and

WHEREAS, if approved the Police Department will receive 30 LT Level IIIA Ballistic Helmets, valued at \$9,810.00, approximately 20 sets of Personal Protection Equipment, (PPE), valued at \$29,017.14, and

WHEREAS, all equipment will be purchased by the State and distributed by the Dona Ana County of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, no adjustment to the City's budget is needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces,:

THAT, the City Manager of the City of Las Cruces is hereby authorized to accept the equipment for and on behalf of the City of Las Cruces, and

(II)

THAT, City staff and officials are authorized to do all deeds necessary in the accomplishment of the herein above.



**AGREEMENT UPON RECEIPT OF EQUIPMENT
Domestic Preparedness Equipment Program FY 2005**

WHEREAS, the City of Las Cruces Police Department ("the City") is in receipt of preparedness equipment, transferred to it by the County of Dona Ana, through its Office of Emergency Management ("the County"), which equipment will be used for the protection of the residents of the City and the County; and,

WHEREAS, the acquisition of this preparedness equipment is funded by the New Mexico Department of Public Safety, Office of Emergency Management pursuant to a grant funded by the United States Department of Homeland Security Office, Office for Domestic Preparedness "Homeland Security Grant Program" (hereinafter "the Program"); and the equipment is to be used to increase the City's ability to respond to a terrorist incident involving weapons of mass destruction;

NOW THEREFORE, The City acknowledges receipt of the equipment and, after inspection of the same, states as follows:

1. The equipment as listed in the lists attached hereto as "Attachment A," is present and in good working order. The equipment will be used to increase the City's ability to respond to a terrorist incident involving weapons of mass destruction.
2. The City will advise the County in writing before transferring any of this equipment to other persons; jurisdictions or entities and the City shall maintain records of the condition and whereabouts of such equipment.
3. The County provides no warranties as regards to the supplied equipment.
4. The City agrees and accepts that the County is not liable for any injuries or damages that arise out of the transfer, ownership or use of the supplied equipment.
5. The City agrees to assume full responsibility for whatever training, upkeep, maintenance, storage costs, etc. are necessitated by its custody and use of the supplied equipment.
6. The City acknowledges that the State retains the right to inspect/inventory all equipment supplies hereunder.
7. This Agreement shall remain in effect throughout the entire period of use and possession by the City of the above referenced equipment.
