BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

The New Mexico Brewers Guild will sponsor the 3rd Annual Blazin' Brewfest, a beer festival to be held on Main Street, Saturday, May 2, 2015. Little Toad Creek Distillery is requesting approval to sell spirituous liquors for consumption within a restricted and secured area during the event.

Approval by the Las Cruces City Council is required prior to the submission of the Public Celebration Permit Application to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming"). Final approval by Alcohol and Gaming would allow Little Toad Creek Distillery to sell spirituous liquors within the restricted and secured area between 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on May 2, 2015.

The authorization of the Public Celebration Permit Application will comply with the requirements of the Las Cruces Municipal Code, Section 5-1, which restricts alcohol consumption in public places to areas approved by Alcohol and Gaming only.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Brewers Guild is sponsoring the 3rd Annual Blazin' Brewfest, a beer festival to be held on Saturday, May 2, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Little Toad Creek Distillery requests approval to sell spirituous liquors for consumption within a restricted and secured area during the event; and

WHEREAS, approval by the Las Cruces City Council is required prior to submission of the Public Celebration Permit Application to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming"); and

WHEREAS, final approval by Alcohol and Gaming would allow Little Toad Creek Distillery to sell spirituous liquors for consumption within a restricted and secured area during the 3rd Annual Blazin' Brewfest; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Public Celebration Permit Application will comply with the requirements of the Las Cruces Municipal Code, Section 5-1, which restricts alcohol consumption in public to areas approved by Alcohol and Gaming only.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces:

THAT Little Toad Creek Distillery is hereby authorized to continue with the permitting process for the Public Celebration Permit Application, attached hereto as

Exhibit "A", to allow spirituous liquors to be sold for consumption within a restricted and secured area between 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 2, 2015.




