

BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

The Foundation for Las Cruces Museums ("The Foundation") is sponsoring a combined museums event called "Transformations" on Friday, May 15, 2015 from 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. The combined museums area will be restricted and secured so that patrons will be able to roam, by walkways and open courts, throughout the Branigan Cultural Center, the Museum of Art, and the Museum of Nature and Science. The Foundation has requested that High Desert Brewing Company serve beer in the open court area of the Branigan Cultural Center during the event.

Approval by the Las Cruces City Council is required prior to the submission of the Public Celebration Permit Application to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming"). Final approval by Alcohol and Gaming would allow High Desert Brewing Company to sell beer within a restricted and secured area between 5:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. on Friday, May 15, 2015.

The authorization of the Public Celebration Permit Application will comply with the requirements of the Las Cruces Municipal Code, Section 5-1, which restricts alcohol consumption in public places to areas approved by Alcohol and Gaming only.

The City Council is informed that:

WHEREAS, The Foundation for Las Cruces Museums is sponsoring an event called "Transformations" on Friday, May 15, 2015 from 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. in which patrons will be able to roam, by walkways and open courtyards, throughout the Branigan Cultural Center, the Museum of Art, and the Museum of Nature and Science; and

WHEREAS, High Desert Brewing Company requests approval to sell beer for consumption within a restricted and secured area during the event; and

WHEREAS, approval by the Las Cruces City Council is required prior to submission of the Public Celebration Permit Application to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming"); and

WHEREAS, final approval by Alcohol and Gaming would allow High Desert Brewing Company to sell beer for consumption in the courtyard of the Branigan Cultural Center from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. during the event; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Public Celebration Permit Application will comply with the requirements of the Las Cruces Municipal Code, Section 5-1, which restricts alcohol consumption in public to areas approved by Alcohol and Gaming only.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces:

THAT High Desert Brewing Company is hereby authorized to continue with the permitting process for the Public Celebration Permit Application, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", to allow beer to be sold for consumption within a restricted and secured area in the courtyard of the Branigan Cultural Center between 5:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. on Friday, May 15, 2015.




