BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

Under Resolution No. 15-193, the Economic Development Committee of Las Cruces was established to advise the City Council on comprehensive, economic development issues facing the City. It has been determined that the committee should be established on a permanent basis. Therefore, this ordinance proposes to incorporate the composition, duties, and terms for members in the appropriate chapter of the Las Cruces Municipal Code (LCMC), 1997, as amended. Due to the composition established under Resolution No. 15-193, the Economic Development Committee would be a non-standard board with representatives from the City Council (three members appointed by the Mayor), one representative from each City Council district, and four assigned department-level directors (Assistant City Manager/Chief Operating Officer, Community Development Director, Public Works Director, and Utilities Director). Other than staff appointments, the terms of office for each Councillor and representative would coincide with the Councillor's term of office.

Incorporated in the body of the proposed ordinance, but not the LCMC, is the preservation of the existing committee members appointed under Resolution No. 15-193 through their term of office

as established by the proposed ordinance. This is proposed to ensure that current members to the committee maintain their membership on the committee. However, at the completion of their term of office (between two and four years) any new City Council district representatives would be appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the City Council, rather than appointed by the Councillor for the district which they represent.

Contemporaneously with the adoption of the proposed ordinance, a resolution proposing to rescind Resolution No. 15-193 will be on the agenda for the City Council's consideration to avoid any potential conflicts between the LCMC and the resolution.

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A NEW SUBDIVISION XX OF DIVISION 3 (NONSTANDARD BOARDS) OF ARTICLE IV (BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES) OF CHAPTER 2 (ADMINISTRATION) OF THE LAS CRUCES MUNICIPAL CODE, 1997, AS AMENDED, ESTABLISHING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE.

The City Council is informed that:

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 15-193 was adopted on April 6, 2015 establishing the Economic Development Committee of Las Cruces; and

WHEREAS, the resolution was adopted in order to establish the committee to address pending issues related to the City's long-term and comprehensive economic development plans, and needs; and

WHEREAS, the board provisions of the Las Cruces Municipal Code (LCMC), 1997, as amended, need to be updated to establish the Economic Development Committee as a permanent, non-standard board; and

WHEREAS, provisions detailing the committee's duties, composition, appointment and terms are reflected in Exhibit "A" of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces:

(I)

THAT Subdivision XX of Division 3 (Nonstandard Boards) of Article IV (Boards, Commissions, and Committees) of Chapter 2 (Administration) of the LCMC, 1997, as amended, is hereby approved creating the Economic Development Committee as shown in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made part of this ordinance.

(II)

THAT the current appointments to the Economic Development Committee of Las

Cruces made under the authority of Resolution No. 15-193 shall retain the terms of office as follows:

- a. District 5 City Councillor: through November 20, 2017,
- b. District 6 City Councillor: through November 20, 2017,
- c. Council District 1 representative: through March 31, 2020,
- d. Council District 2 representative: through March 31, 2020,
- e. Council District 3 representative: through March 31, 2018,
- f. Council District 4 representative: through March 31, 2020,
- g. Council District 5 representative: through March 31, 2018,
- h. Council District 6 representative: through March 31, 2018, and

due to the election of November 3, 2015, the Mayor shall appoint another member of the City Council in accordance with this ordinance for the term of office completed by former City Councillor Nathan Small of Council District 4, and that this specific section of this ordinance shall automatically expire with the completion of the last term of office for the representative appointed under its authority.

(III)

THAT City staff is hereby authorized to do all deeds necessary in the accomplishment of the herein above.

Subdivision XX. – Economic Development Committee

Sec. 2-1011. - Established.

There is established an economic development committee.

Sec. 2-1012. - Duties.

The economic development committee shall advise the city council on matters related to comprehensive, citywide economic development efforts by the City, including but not limited to making recommendations for the:

- (a) adoption and revisions to local economic development plans in accordance with state law or this Municipal Code and review of other City policies that may affect the City's ability to undertake comprehensive economic development efforts;
- (b) development and implementation of:
 - a. the City's Economic Gardening Program,
 - b. the Local Economic Development Act,
 - c. other City incentive programs,
 - d. State of New Mexico incentive programs as authorized by state law,
 - e. efforts to retain and/or expand existing businesses and industries, and
 - f. responses to "globalization";
- (c) development of and reporting on economic indicators;
- (d) market and continue development of the West Mesa Industrial Park;
- (e) support the development and implementation of initiatives in the areas of:
 - a. workforce development,
 - b. entrepreneurship,
 - c. innovation,
 - d. economic sustainability; and
- (f) provide recommendation on any economic development matters as specifically requested by the city council.

Sec. 2-1013. - Membership.

- (a) Three members of the City Council;
- (b) One resident representative from each City Council district;
- (c) The assistant city manager/chief operating officer or their designee;
- (d) The community development director or their designee;
- (e) The public works director or their designee; and
- (f) The utilities director or their designee.

Sec. 2-1014. - Appointment of members; terms.

- (a) In accordance with Section 2-188 and other than city staff, the mayor, with the advice and consent of the city council, shall appoint the members of the committee.
- (b) The term for members of the City Council to this committee shall coincide with their term of office.
- (c) Terms of office: resident representatives
 - 1) Initial Term: The initial term of the resident representatives appointed shall coincide with the term of office for the district councilor from whose district they were appointed to represent.
 - 2) Subsequent Terms: Thereafter, all said appointments shall be fixed in four-year terms and the expiration date of all appointments shall be March 31st or until the member is replaced.
- (d) Staff appointments shall be effective date of this Section and shall serve as long as they hold such position.
