Robert Garza, City Manager said in February you approved an ordinance that gave staff authority to solicit bids and that was done this morning.

Erik Harrigan, RBC Financial Advisor said there were three bidders with Raymond James providing the lowest bid at 3.5139. There were 14 bids. It will deliver about \$7.2 million for the project. There is also an optional redemption feature.

Katherine Cregan, Modrall-Sperling Bond Council said we've included the final maturity schedule. We purchased principal and interest insurance. There's capitalized interest until June of 2017.

Councillor Levatino asked why are the interest rates on the maturity schedule varied?

Erik Harrigan said the average rate was 3.51 and they typically go up over time. The interest rates range between 3.25 and 3.7. There's also re-offering yields.

Councillor Levatino asked is it a variable rate and not a fixed rate?

Erik Harrigan said they change by maturity.
