BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

Ordinance No. 2512 which established the Veterans Advisory Board (VAB) specifies that membership will consist of eleven (11) positions representing veteran organizations and two (2) at-large seats. In an effort to broaden the representation of local veterans, specifically student and younger veterans, a third at-large position is being recommended. This additional at-large position is required to be affiliated with student veterans.

In order to maintain the existing number of thirteen (13) voting members, the new ordinance also seeks to remove one of the positions. The position being eliminated is identified as an established veteran organization as approved by the board members. The new ordinance will also replace the Veteran of Foreign Wars, Post 6917 with the United Military Women of the South West.

There is no change to the quorum requirements or total number of board members.

The Mayor, with the advice and consent of the City Council, will maintain authority to appoint all members of the VAB.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING LAS CRUCES MUNICIPAL CODE (LCMC), 1997, SECTION 2-977, MEMBERSHIP, PERTAINING TO THE VETERANS ADVISORY BOARD, AND ENACTING A NEW SECTION 2-977.

The City Council is informed that:

WHEREAS, the City of Las Cruces has established a Veterans Advisory Board (VAB) for the purpose of advising City Council on matters affecting veterans and to propose solutions to alleviate or remedy the needs of local veterans; and

WHEREAS, the existing ordinance dictates the voting membership shall be made up of one member each from eleven veteran organizations and two members-at-large; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to broaden the representation of local veterans, a third member-at-large position who is affiliated with student veterans is being added; and

WHEREAS, to maintain the existing number of positions on the VAB the position identified as an established veteran organization as approved by the board members will be eliminated and the Veteran of Foreign Wars, Post 6917 will be replaced by the United Military Women of the South West.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Las Cruces:

(I)

THAT City Council hereby repeals LCMC, 1997, Section 2-977, Membership.

(II)

THAT a new LCMC, 1997, Section 2-977, Membership, is hereby enacted as shown in Exhibit "A" and attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance.

(III)

THAT City staff is hereby authorized to do all deeds necessary in the accomplishment of the herein above.

Sec. 2-977. Membership.

The veterans advisory board shall be made up of 13 members. All members must be veterans residing in the county.

There shall be one voting member each who represents veterans' organizations. These organizations shall be the American Legion Post 10; Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 3242; United Military Women of the South West; Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 10124; Disabled American Veterans Chapter 10; Military Officers Association of America, Mesilla Valley Chapter; Marine Corps League, El Perro Diablo Chapter; Vietnam Veterans of America, Chapter 431; Special Forces Association, Chapter 80; and the Military Order of the Purple Heart Mesilla Valley #2004.

There will be three voting members designated as members-at-large. One member-at-large position shall be affiliated with student veterans.

White Sands Missile Range and a representative of the state department of veterans' service will be invited to provide an ex-officio nonvoting member on the board. Representatives of each local office of federal senators and congress members, and state legislators will be invited to attend meetings.

Sec. 2-977. Membership.

The veterans advisory board shall be made up of 13 members. All members must be veterans residing in the county.

There shall be one voting member each who represents veterans' organizations. These organizations shall be the American Legion Post 10, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 3242, ~~Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 6917~~ **United Military Women of the South West**, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 10124, Disabled American Veterans Chapter 10, Military Officers Association of America, Mesilla Valley Chapter, Marine Corps League, El Perro Diablo Chapter, Vietnam Veterans of America, Chapter 431, Special Forces Association, Chapter 80, **and the** Military Order of the Purple Heart Mesilla Valley #2004 ~~and an established veteran organization as approved by the board members.~~

There will be ~~two~~ **three** voting members designated as members-at-large. **One member-at-large position shall be affiliated with student veterans.**

White Sands Missile Range and a representative of the state department of veterans' service will be invited to provide an ex-officio nonvoting member on the board. Representatives of each local office of federal senators and congress members, and state legislators will be invited to attend meetings.
