BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

Pursuant to state law, an application for the transfer of ownership of a liquor license must be accompanied by a resolution of the Las Cruces City Council approving of and consenting to the transfer after a public hearing.

Las Cruces Hotel Management Corporation applied to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming") for a transfer of ownership of Liquor License No. 0190, with on premise consumption and package sales, to Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces, located at 705 South Telshor Boulevard, Las Cruces, New Mexico. Alcohol and Gaming granted preliminary approval by letter dated May 25, 2016.

The City Council is required to hold a public hearing within 45 days of receipt of the preliminary approval from Alcohol and Gaming. A public hearing to review this issue is scheduled for Tuesday, July 5, 2016, as part of the regular City Council meeting which begins at 1:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 700 North Main Street, Las Cruces, New Mexico. Notice of this public hearing was published in the *Las Cruces Sun-News* on June 5 and 12, 2016.

Council may approve or disapprove the transfer. However, Council's disapproval must be based on substantial evidence that the transfer of ownership of the license would adversely affect the health, safety or welfare of the citizens of the City of Las Cruces. Council may also fail to either approve or disapprove the license. If Council fails to approve or disapprove the license within 30 days after the public hearing, the Director of Alcohol and Gaming may give final approval of this license.

The City Council is informed that:

WHEREAS, Las Cruces Hotel Management applied to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming") for a transfer of ownership of Liquor License No. 0190, with on premise consumption and package sales, to Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces, located at 705 South Telshor Boulevard, Las Cruces, New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, Alcohol and Gaming has granted preliminary approval for the transfer of the license; and



Greetings:

The Director of the Alcohol and Gaming Division has review the referenced application and has granted Preliminary Approval; it is being forwarded to you in accordance with Section 60-6B-4 NMSA of the Liquor Control Act.

While the law states that "within forty-five (45) days after receipt of a Notice from the Alcohol and Gaming Division, the governing body shall hold a Public Hearing in the question of whether the department should approve the proposed issuance or transfer", we recognize the inherent conflict between the new 30 day notice and the existing 45 day hearing requirement. Extensions to the 45-day hearing requirement will be granted when necessary to allow for compliance with the 30 day notice. Notice of the Public Hearing required by the Liquor Control Act shall be given by the governing body by publishing a notice of the date, time, and place of the hearing twice during the 30 days prior to the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial limits of the governing body The first notice must be published at least thirty (30) days before the hearing. Both publications must occur before a hearing can be conducted. The notice shall include: (A) Name and address of the Applicant/Licensee; (B) The action proposed to be taken by the Alcohol and Gaming Division; and (C) The location of the licensed premises. The governing body is required to send notice by certified mail to the Applicant of the date, time, and place of the Public Hearing. The governing body may designate a Hearing Officer to conduct the hearing. A record shall be made of the hearing.

THE APPLICANT IS SEEKING A TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF LIQUOR LICENSE NO. 0190 WITH ON PREMISE CONSUMPTION AND PACKAGE SALES. THE APPLICANT CURRENTLY OWNES THIS LIQUOR LICENSE BUT THE STOCKHOLDERS OF THE CORPORATION HAVE CHANGED.


The governing body may disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license if:

- 1) The proposed location is within an area where the sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by the laws of New Mexico. (The governing body may disapprove if the proposed location is within 300 feet of a church or school unless the license has been located at this location prior to 1981 or unless the Applicant/Licensee has obtained a waiver from the Local Option District governing body for the proposed licensed premises).
- 2) The issuance or transfer would be in violation of a zoning or other ordinance of the governing body. The governing body may disapprove if the proposed location is not properly zoned. Because this office is in receipt of a Zoning Statement from the governing body, this is not a basis for disapproval. Attached is a copy of a Zoning Statement from the local governing body.
- 3) The issuance would be detrimental to the public health, safety, or morals of the residents of the Local Option District. Disapproval by the governing body on public health, safety, or morals must be based on and supported by substantial evidence pertaining to the specific prospective transferee or location and a copy of the record must be submitted to the Alcohol and Gaming Division.

Within thirty (30) days after the Public Hearing, the governing body **shall** notify the Alcohol and Gaming Division as to whether the local governing body has approved or disapproved the issuance or transfer of the license by signing the enclosed original Page 1 of the Application. The original Page 1 of the Application must be returned together with the notice of publication(s). **If the governing body fails to either approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license within thirty days after the Public Hearing, the Director may give Final Approval to the issuance or transfer of the license.**

If the governing body disapproves the issuance or transfer of the license, it shall notify the Alcohol and Gaming Division within thirty (30) days setting forth the reasons for the disapproval. A copy of the Minutes of the Public Hearing shall be submitted to the Alcohol and Gaming Division with the notice of disapproval (Page 1 of the Application page noting disapproval).



705 S. Telshor Blvd. – Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces**

As requested, Traffic Engineering has completed a traffic investigation for Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces located at 705 S. Telshor Blvd. in Las Cruces, New Mexico. The following information is submitted for review:

- Hotel Encanto de Las Cruces is located at the southeast corner of intersection of S. Telshor Blvd. and Foothills Road. According to the Mesilla Valley MPO 2015 Traffic Flow Map the most recent traffic volume on S. Telshor Blvd. near this location is approximately 20,320 vehicles per day and traffic volume on Foothills Road is approximately 10,440 vehicles per day.
- The Mesilla Valley MPO classifies S. Telshor Blvd. as a principal arterial roadway and Foothills Road as a collector roadway adjacent to the subject location. Both roadways serve mainly commercial uses near the property.
- The subject property has two driveways along Foothills Road. Sight distance of both driveways may be affected by landscaping, structures, vertical curvature and elevation difference between the Foothills Road and the property. The most western driveway along Foothills is in close proximity to the signalized intersection of S. Telshor Blvd. and Foothills Road and therefore may experience operational issues for certain turn movements. No other sight distance or operational problems are currently known at the driveways.
- The speed limit along S. Telshor Blvd. near the subject property is 35 mph and the speed limit along Foothills road near the subject property is 30 mph.

The approval of a Liquor License Application at this location does not appear to adversely impact traffic operations along these roadway segments. Feel free to contact me if additional information is needed.
