BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

Pursuant to state law, an application for the transfer of location of a liquor license must be accompanied by a resolution of the Las Cruces City Council approving of and consenting to the transfer after a public hearing.

RM Beverages, LLC d/b/a RM Beverage applied to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming") for a transfer of ownership and location, with on premise consumption only, of Liquor License No. 2651. Alcohol and Gaming granted preliminary approval of the license transfer by letter dated August 12, 2016.

The City Council is required to hold a public hearing within 45 days of receipt of the preliminary approval from Alcohol and Gaming. A public hearing to review this issue is scheduled for Monday, October 3, 2016, as part of the regular City Council meeting which begins at 1:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 700 North Main Street, Las Cruces, New Mexico. Notice of this public hearing was published in the *Las Cruces Bulletin* on September 2 and 9, 2016.

The City Council may approve or disapprove the transfer. However, the City Council's disapproval must be based on substantial evidence that the transfer of ownership and location of the license would adversely affect the health, safety or welfare of the citizens of Las Cruces. The City Council may also fail to either approve or disapprove the license. If the City Council fails to approve or disapprove the license within 30 days after the public hearing, the Director of Alcohol and Gaming may give final approval to the transfer of the license.



Greetings:

The Director of the Alcohol and Gaming Division has reviewed the referenced Application and granted **Conditional Preliminary Approval**. It is being forwarded to you for Local Option District approval or disapproval of the Liquor License Application.

While the law states that "within forty-five (45) days after receipt of a Notice from the Alcohol and Gaming Division, the governing body shall hold a Public Hearing in the question of whether the department should approve the proposed issuance or transfer", we recognize the potential for conflict between the requirement for publication of 30 day notice and the 45 day hearing requirement. Should the Local Governing Body be unable to meet one of these requirements, please send a Request for Waiver/Extension by email to the assigned AGD Hearing Officer listed on page 2.

Notice of the Public Hearing required by the Liquor Control Act **shall be given by the governing body by publishing a notice** of the date, time, and place of the hearing **twice during the 30 days prior to the hearing** in a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial limits of the governing body. **The first notice must be published at least thirty (30) days before the hearing. Both publications must occur before a hearing can be conducted.** The notice shall include:

- (A) Name and address of the Applicant/Licensee;
- (B) The action proposed to be taken by the Alcohol & Gaming Division;
- (C) The location of the licensed premises.


The governing body is required to send notice by certified mail to the Applicant of the date, time, and place of the Public Hearing. The governing body may designate a Hearing Officer to conduct the hearing. **A record shall be made** of the hearing.

THE APPLICANT IS SEEKING A TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP AND LOCATION OF LIQUOR LICENSE NO. 2651 WITH ON PREMISE CONSUMPTION ONLY. THE APPLICANT IS ALSO SEEKING A WAIVER AS THE ESTABLISHMENT IS WITHIN 300 FEET OF A CHURCH AND SCHOOL.

Within thirty (30) days after the Public Hearing, the governing body shall notify the Alcohol and Gaming Division of their decision to approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license by signing the enclosed original Page 1 of the Application. The original Page 1 of the Application must be returned together with the notices of publication. **If the Governing Body fails to either approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license within thirty days after the Public Hearing, the Director may issue the license.**

If the Governing Body disapproves the issuance or transfer of the license, it shall notify the Alcohol and Gaming Division within thirty (30) days setting forth the reasons for the disapproval. A copy of the Minutes of the Public Hearing shall be submitted to the Alcohol and Gaming Division with the Notice of Disapproval (*Page 1 of the Application, noting disapproval*).

As requested, Traffic Engineering has completed a traffic investigation for RM Beverage at the proposed location of 334 S. Main St. in Las Cruces, New Mexico. The most current Site Layout Plan (refer to the attached plan) was submitted by the developer. The following information is submitted for review:

- RM Beverage is proposed to be at the northwest corner of the intersection of E. Amador Ave. and S. Main St. According to the Mesilla Valley MPO 2015 Traffic Flow Map, the current traffic volume on S. Water Street is approximately 5,360 vehicles per day and traffic volume on S. Main St. is approximately 2,150 vehicles per day. Traffic volume on E. Amador Ave. is 6,670 vehicles per day while traffic volume on Bowman Ave. is not available.
- The Mesilla Valley MPO classifies S. Main St., E. Amador Ave. and Bowman Ave. as principal arterials and S. Water St. as a local street near the subject location. All streets near the subject location primarily serve commercial use near the property.
- The site layout plan indicates the property will have a small parking lot that has one driveway with full access along S. Water St. and another right-in, right-out driveway along Bowman Ave. It also shows on-street parking along Bowman Ave. that may obstruct drivers' sight distance at the driveway entrance. No other anticipated sight distance or operations problems are currently known at those driveways.
- The speed limit along S. Main St. and Bowman Ave. is 25 mph near the subject property and the speed limit along E. Amador Ave. is 35 mph near the subject property. There is not a posted speed limit along S. Water St.






The 2001 Las Cruces Zoning Code, as amended, requires restaurants to provide one (1) automobile parking space for every 5 seats and one (1) bicycle parking space per one thousand (1,000) square feet of gross floor area.

IMPACT ANALYSIS:

The subject property is located off of S. Main St. which is designated as a major arterial and is designed to accommodate moderate traffic and land uses such as restaurants. Zoning in this area is DDC (Downtown Development Code). The applicant is requesting a transfer of ownership and location of a liquor license. In terms of a transportation and land use perspective, this seems to be an appropriate location and request.

STATEMENT OF ZONING
