PURPOSE(S) OF ACTION: To approve, disapprove, or not approve or disapprove the issuance of a Beer and Wine Restaurant Liquor License to Japanese Kitchen.

BACKGROUND / KEY ISSUES / CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

Pursuant to state law, the application for the issuance of a Beer and Wine Restaurant Liquor License must be accompanied by a resolution of the City Council approving of and consenting to the issuance after a public hearing.

Japanese Kitchen of Las Cruces, LLC d/b/a Japanese Kitchen applied to the Alcohol & Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming") for a Beer and Wine Restaurant Liquor License at 141 Roadrunner Parkway, Suite 115, Las Cruces, New Mexico. Alcohol and Gaming granted preliminary approval on October 19, 2009.

The City Council is required to hold a public hearing within 45 days after the date of receipt of the preliminary approval from Alcohol and Gaming. A public hearing to review this issue is scheduled for Monday, November 16, 2009, beginning at 1:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 200 North Church Street, Las Cruces, New Mexico. Notice of this public hearing was published in the *Las Cruces Sun-News* on November 1 and 8, 2009, and in the *Las Cruces Bulletin* on October 30 and November 6, 2009.

Council may approve or disapprove the issuance of the license. However, Council's disapproval must be based on substantial evidence that the issuance of the license would adversely affect the health, safety or welfare of the citizens of the City of Las Cruces.

Council may also fail to either approve or disapprove the license. If Council fails to approve or disapprove the license within 30 days after the public hearing, the Director of Alcohol and Gaming may give final approval of this license.

The City Council of the City of Las Cruces is informed that:

WHEREAS, Japanese Kitchen of Las Cruces, LLC d/b/a Japanese Kitchen applied to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department of the State of New Mexico ("Alcohol and Gaming") for a Beer and Wine Restaurant Liquor License at 141 Roadrunner Parkway, Suite 115, Las Cruces, New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2009 Alcohol and Gaming granted preliminary approval for the issuance of the liquor license, as evidenced by their letter with the application attached; and

Greetings:

The Director of the Alcohol and Gaming Division has reviewed the referenced Application and is being forwarded to you in accordance with Section 60-6B-4 NMSA of the Liquor Control Act.

Within forty-five (45) days after receipt of a Notice from the Alcohol and Gaming Division, the governing body shall hold a Public Hearing in the question of whether the department should approve the proposed issuance or transfer. Notice of the Public Hearing required by the Liquor Control Act shall be given by the governing body by publishing a notice of the date, time, and place of the hearing at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial limits of the governing body, which requires that two weeks of publication must be satisfied before a hearing can be conducted. The notice shall include: (A) Name and address of the Applicant/Licensee; (B) The action proposed to be taken by the Alcohol and Gaming Division; and (C) The location of the licensed premises. The governing body is required to send notice by certified mail to the Applicant of the date, time, and place of the Public Hearing. The governing body may designate a Hearing Officer to conduct the hearing. A record shall be made of the hearing.


The governing body may disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license if:

- 1) The proposed location is within an area where the sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by the laws of New Mexico. (The governing body may disapprove if the proposed location is within 300 feet of a church or school unless the license has been located at this location prior to 1981 or unless the Applicant/Licensee has obtained a waiver from the Local Option District governing body for the proposed licensed premises).
- 2) The issuance or transfer would be in violation of a zoning or other ordinance of the governing body. The governing body may disapprove if the proposed location is not properly zoned. Because this office is in receipt of a Zoning Statement from the governing body, this is not a basis for disapproval. Attached is a copy of a Zoning Statement from the local governing body.
- 3) The issuance would be detrimental to the public health, safety, or morals of the residents of the Local Option District. Disapproval by the governing body on public health, safety, or morals must be based on and supported by substantial evidence pertaining to the specific prospective transferee or location and a copy of the record must be submitted to the Alcohol and Gaming Division.

Within thirty (30) days after the Public Hearing, the governing body **shall** notify the Alcohol and Gaming Division as to whether the local governing body has approved or disapproved the issuance or transfer of the license by signing the enclosed original Page 1 of the Application. The original Page 1 of the Application must be returned together with the notice of publication(s). If the governing body fails to either approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license within thirty days after the Public Hearing, the Director may give Final Approval to the issuance or transfer of the license.

If the governing body disapproves the issuance or transfer of the license, it shall notify the Alcohol and Gaming Division within thirty (30) days setting forth the reasons for the disapproval. A copy of the Minutes of the Public Hearing shall be submitted to the Alcohol and Gaming Division with the notice of disapproval (Page 1 of the Application page noting disapproval).

As requested, Traffic Engineering has completed a traffic investigation for Japanese Kitchen, 141 Roadrunner Parkway, Suite 115, Las Cruces., New Mexico. The following information is submitted for review:

- Roadrunner Parkway at this location carries approximately 10,000 vehicles per day.
- Roadrunner Parkway is operated as a four lane roadway with raised median serving primarily office and commercial property in this area.
- Access to the property in question is off of Roadrunner Parkway. No potential sight distance or operational problems exist.
- The speed limit on Roadrunner Parkway is posted at 35 mph.

The approval of a Liquor License Transfer at this location does not appear it will adversely impact traffic operations along this segment of roadway.

PARKING REQUIREMENTS:

The 2001 Las Cruces Zoning Code, as amended, requires restaurants to provide one (1) automobile parking space for every 2-5 seats and one (1) bicycle parking space per one thousand (1,000) square feet of gross floor area. However, because the business is in a shopping/business center, shopping/business center parking requirements must be followed. As the center currently exists, it complies with current parking standards.

IMPACT ANALYSIS:

The applicant is requesting a Beer and Wine On-Premise Consumption Only Liquor License for this establishment. The subject property is located on Roadrunner Parkway which is designated as a principal arterial and is designed to accommodate moderate to heavy traffic and land uses such as restaurants. The parcel is part of a Planned Unit Development (PUD) known as The Boulders at Roadrunner Office Complex Plan. The Boulders at Roadrunner Office Complex PUD utilizes provisions from the 2001 Zoning Code, as amended. In terms of a transportation and land use perspective, this seems to be an appropriate location and request.






